### Community Group Questions

1. What is God teaching you in your personal bible reading or in the series on Exodus?
2. Are you that "1 in 5" group that has some skeletons in the old family-tree-closet? Any stories you'd care to share?
3. What parts of the bible do you find the most challenging to read?
4. Read through Matthew 1 – specifically the genealogy of Jesus. Take a look at a couple of names from the list below.
