It's one thing to hear God's Word, it's another to apply it! Answering the questions on your own before your group meets will help you be fully engaged in the discussion.

Community Group Questions

1. What makes a plague so bad? Can you think of any event from your lifetime that would be the closest thing to "plague"? Of the first 4 plagues, which would be the worst for you to have to face?
2. Read the following verses and summarize how they emphasize that the Lord revealing himself through these events:
 - 📖 Exodus 7:17; 8:10, 22
 - 📖 Exodus 9:14, 16, 29
 - 📖 Exodus 10:1-2; 11:9; 12:26-27
3. God could have miraculously transported the people from Egypt to the promised land, bypassing the hassles of Pharaoh and the wilderness. What difference would that have made in their lives and experience? How did their experiences help them learn more about God? What does that tell us about our own lives?
4. In light of question 3, compare what the Israelites went through with what the disciples went through with Jesus. How did Jesus reveal himself through their difficult experiences?
5. How have you learned about God through your life experiences. What might he be teaching you through the good or bad you may be experiencing right now?
