Community Group Questions

1. What was your favorite home-cooked meal growing up? How often did you have it? Was there anything your parents made that you detested?
2. Read Exodus 16:1-5. Obviously, sin, grumbling, and complaining were distorting their perception of the past. Sin always distorts. How can we practically resist this? How can we anchor ourselves in truth?
3. Do you ever feel uncomfortable admitting your absolute dependence on God? Why do you think we often feel the need to be independent?
4. Do you feel more dependent on God now than when you first became a Christian? In what areas of your life is God revealing to you your need for him?
5. Spend some time in groups praying that God would help us, as a church and as individuals, grow in dependence on him.

REMEMBERING

Memorizing is one of the best ways of making truth stick. You can memorize something if you repeat it enough times. Try reading the verse 5 times a day until it sticks! Choose a part of it for your kids if needed.
