- ◆ **19:3-6** - Moses ascends; God makes proposition

- ◆ **19:14-15** - Moses descends; 2 days preparation, boundary set up
- ◆ **19:16-19a** - Morning of the 3rd Day;
→ *thunder, lightning, thick cloud, trumpet blast, smoke, fire, earthquake*
- ◆ **19:19b-20** - Moses speaks; God answers and descends to the mountain
- ◆ **19:21-24** - Moses ascends; Another warning given
- ◆ **19:25-20:20** - Moses descends; God gives the commands

Community Group Questions

1. Did the introduction to the sermon make you think about all the legal agreements you are involved in? How many do you think you have? What is our attitude towards most of the agreements you we are involved in?
2. How is a covenant different from a contract? How could our indifference toward human contracts influence our attitude towards being in covenant with God?
3. What event in Exodus 19 did you find most interesting? Why?
4. After hearing the message, has it given you a different perspective on the 10 Commandments? Explain.
5. Review the three main points that reveal who God is and what he is doing in this event. How does a clear understanding of those truths affect the way we think about God in our every day lives?

REMEMBERING

Memorizing is one of the best ways of making truth stick. You can memorize something if you repeat it enough times. Try reading the verse 5 times a day until it sticks! Choose a part of it for your kids if needed.
