On Sunday mornings, **children up to Grade 2** leave partway through the service for their own program. A staffed nursery is available for **infants** during the entire service. Children in **Grades 3 to 5** have their own program, after the service from 11:15am to noon. This program follows the sermon series, so it helps kids in this age group engage during the worship service.

- ☆ **Easter:** Please escort your children (up to Grade 2) to their classes when the Worship Leader announces that the children can leave for their classes. If you need help finding the right class, there will be someone at the Children's Table in the foyer to help you.
- ☆ **Offering:** We will be collecting an offering for those who regularly attend. If you are visiting with us, please don't feel obligated to give.

## MINISTRIES

**Emmaus (for Grades 6-12, Sunday 6pm):** We help youth grow in their relationship with God, no matter what stage of faith they are at. This involves: a relationship building time (group games and activities); a worship time; a time dedicated to looking into God's Word; and a discussion and prayer time. We also have monthly youth activities that are designed to create a healthy environment for youth to let loose and get to know other youth.

**Play & Grow (Wednesdays, 9-11am):** A drop-in play-time for caregivers and their preschoolers to play and interact with other parents and children. Offered in conjunction with Ontario Early Years.

**Divorce Care & DC4K - Divorce Care for Kids (Tuesdays, 6-8pm):** A specialized program designed to help adults and children cope with the pain of divorce.

**Community Groups (Various days and times):** A Community Group is a small group of people (approx. 6-12) that meets throughout the week. It is held in people's homes or here at the church and is a place where you study, learn, pray, share, and hangout. This is where the primary connections, care, and authentic community take place.
