The prayers of God's people opened the doors for multitudes to come to faith in Christ. *"Every step in the progress of missions is directly traceable to prayer. It has been the preparation for every new triumph and the secret of all success."* - A. T. Pierson
Intercession is made up of two Latin words. The word "Inter" meaning "between"; and "cedere", meaning "to go". An intercessor is a "go between". A mediator acting as a "go between" for someone else. To stand between a lost soul and a just God. To stand between a sick person and their health. To engage in intercessory prayer is to do spiritual battle.

Community Group Questions

1. What is God teaching you through the book of Exodus? What themes are you seeing come up time and time again?
2. What story, so far in Exodus, would you like to have witnessed with your own eyes?
3. Why do you think that we have a tendency to think and act like the results are up to us? Where does this come from? What does this reveal about our understanding of God?
4. Have you ever faced real opposition for doing what is right? Which did you find more discouraging: Opposition from "outside" or "inside"?
5. Have you ever stepped out in obedience and received a "no" from someone? Like, they shut you down? When you and I are disappointed, how can we take our frustrations and concerns to God? What does this look like? Have you ever had to do this?
