Today is a unique day in the history of Summerside. We will be celebrating the great privilege of helping two new churches get started:

1. Q50 Community Church near Grimsby ON

 Over 15 years ago, Graham & Sharon Bulmer were sent out from Summerside to serve in Ecuador. God is now leading them to start a church in a growing community near St. Catharines.



2. Chelsea Green Community Church in Glen Cairn

- Peter & Samantha Barnaby and Derek & Ashley Enns are gathering a core group from Summerside and other London churches to launch a new church that will serve a community that needs a new church. Today, we commission them with their core group to this great task.
- Chelsea Green is currently meeting informally Sunday afternoons, but will begin Sunday morning services in the coming months.



Why should we be starting new churches in Canada?

1. It is the best way to fulfill the Great Commission in our country.

- ♦ We are commanded to make disciples, baptize, and teach that implies a church!
- When the early Christians sent out Paul to spread the Gospel, his primary strategy was to start new churches in the cities he visited.
- ◆ The expectation would be that new churches would be participating in planting other new churches themselves in the future.

2. It is a very effective way to reach new people.

- ◆ "Planting new churches is the most effective evangelistic methodology known under heaven." - C. Peter Wagner - a missiologist who devoted his life to studying church growth.
- ♦ New churches are very effective at reaching new residents and new sociocultural groups of people.
- ◆ A number of studies have confirmed that the new churches gain most of their new members from the "unchurched" while older churches gain most of their new members from other churches.

3. It is an effective way of renewing an established church.

- ♦ It shifts the focus of the established congregation outward to fulfill the mission.
- ♦ It challenges the established congregation to evaluate their own ministries and to consider new approaches.
- It challenges people to sacrifice for the mission, not just financially, but in giving time and energy.
- ♦ It puts pressure on the need to raise up new leaders and provides opportunities for new leaders to emerge.
- ♦ It helps the church to demonstrate a commitment to God's bigger Kingdom purposes beyond our own church. God blesses people and congregations so that they can be a blessing to others.
