- **Shari**, Ian Houghton's sister-in-law, is on a waiting list for kidney transplant
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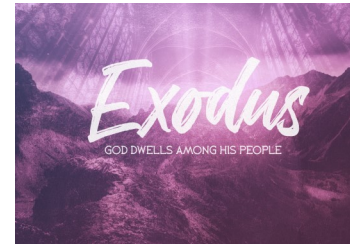
