It's one thing to hear God's Word, it's another to apply it! Answering the questions on your own before your group meets will help you be fully engaged in the

1. Ice Breaker: What's the most lost that you've ever been?
2. Open Question: What did God teach you through his Word from Sunday's sermon?
3. Why do you think it's so hard for us to submit ourselves to God's Word?
4. Have you ever had a time in your life where God's Word was especially helpful in bringing renewal/comfort? If so, explain.
5. Have you ever had a tricky or confusing situation where God's Word helped you navigate? What biblical principles did you rely on?
6. What Bible reading habits do you currently follow? For those of you who – by God's grace – found some success in this, please share some of what you've learned and how you go about your personal bible reading time. Spend time as a group sharing and talking through this area.
7. What small changes could you make in your life to allow you to be more shaped by God through his Word – to make Bible reading more of a "staple" and less of an "add-on" in your life?

REMEMBERING

Memorizing is one of the best ways of making truth stick. You can memorize something if you repeat it enough times. Try reading the verse 5 times a day until it sticks! Choose a part of it for your kids if needed.
