For Our Congregation


- For our Jr. High & leaders who will be at Bedlam (in Muskoka) next weekend - for travel safety, building relationships with Jesus and with each other;

It's one thing to hear God's Word, it's another to apply it! Answering the questions on your own before your group meets will help you be fully engaged in the

Community Group Questions

1. Before hearing the message, what do you think you would have done if you were stranded on a deserted island with other Christians, and you decided to function as a church. After hearing the message, how did that change what you would have done? (don't get bogged down speculating about the island or your rescue!)
2. Read Acts 2:42-47; 4:32-35. Review the 5 things that characterized this first church. Which one(s) do you find the most interesting or challenging? Why?
3. In verse 43, it says a "everyone was filled with awe" (apparently including the unbelievers). Assuming people aren't going to see the miraculous signs the apostles were performing, what do you think would cause a deep sense of awe among believers in our day? How about awe among unbelievers?
4. We are living in a country that provides for the needy. How can we practice the same kind of care for one another that the early church had? What prevents people (maybe you!) from asking others for help?
5. Invite 5 people in your group to pray for one of each of these five characteristics to be developed in our group and in our church.

REMEMBERING

Memorizing is one of the best ways of making truth stick. You can memorize something if you repeat it enough times. Try reading the verse 5 times a day until it sticks! Choose a part of it for your kids if needed.
