Community Group Questions

1. What did God teach you from his word on Sunday? How can you apply that to your life?
2. What children are in your life in whom you can play at least some part in discipling and nurturing?
3. How could you play a role in discipling the children God has placed around you?
4. How have you seen families worship together? Is this something you've done before?
5. From Deuteronomy 6:4-6 – God wanted the adults to teach children the truth of who he is (KNOWLEDGE from the sermon notes). What are some key truths that you think children (say, 0-8 years old) need to know about God? What about pre-teens/teenagers? What would you think they need to know about God?
