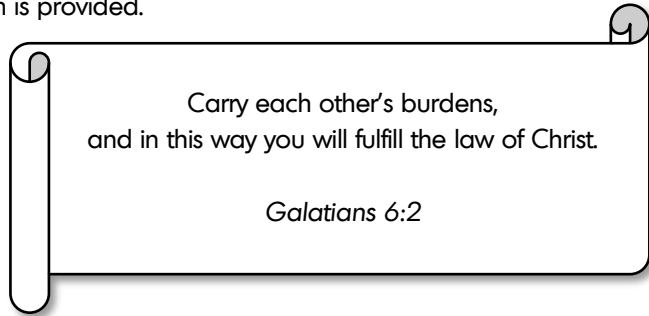

READING

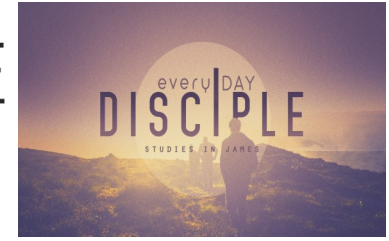
