For Our Congregation

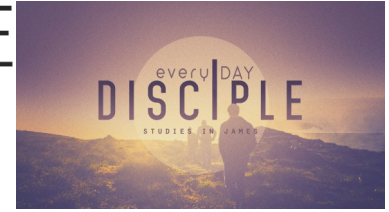
- **Dana Orchard** continues to recover from hip replacement surgery at Parkwood Hospital. Her scheduled discharge date is July 10;
