## APPLYING

It's one thing to hear God's Word, it's another to apply it! Answering the questions on your own before your group meets will help you be fully engaged in the discussion.

### Community Group Questions

1. What did God teach you from his word and how can you apply that to your life?
2. Explain the theological concept of "already but not yet" in your own words.
3. Read through the list and some of the passages below. (List taken from "Kingdom Come" by Sam Storms. Mentor Imprint 2013)
  - ◆ Salvation is now, but also future (Ephesians 2:8 / Romans 5:10)
  - ◆ Justification is now, but also future (Romans 5:1 / Romans 2:13)
  - ◆ We have been adopted into God's family as his children, but our adoption is also yet to come (1 John 3:1; Romans 8:23)
  - ◆ We have been raised with Christ, but the resurrection is also yet future (Ephesians 2 / Romans 6 / Philippians 3 / 1 Corinthians 15)
  - ◆ We have been glorified, but will be glorified (Romans 8:30 / Philippians 3 / 1 John 3)
  - ◆ We have been redeemed, but redemption is yet future (Ephesians 1:4ff. / Romans 8:23 / Romans 13:11)
  - ◆ Regenerate believers are a "new creation" (2 Corinthians 5:17), while we yet await the new heavens and new earth at the return of Jesus.
4. How does Psalm 2 apply to King David? Why is there tension if it only applies to King David, or the Kings of Israel and Judah? How does this text apply to Jesus?
