Community Group Questions

Everyday Disciple:

1. Take some time and think back over this week. Have you had any opportunities to love, care for, bless, or share the gospel with someone? How did it go? What are you learning about making disciples?
2. Since you're preparing to be a Disciple Maker, what have you been studying and learning in God's Word? Share some of that with the group.

From the Sermon:

1. Let's try it out: Can you explain the gospel in one minute? Grab your phone and time it! Offer some thoughts or feedback to people as they share.
2. Read 2 Corinthians 3:12-4:6 as a group. Talk through the passage. What here intrigues you? What here puzzles you? Work through it as a group.
3. Read 1 Corinthians 2:2. What would this reality look like in your life? How would it change our church if each of us used every opportunity (whether with Christians or non-Christians) to "know only Jesus Christ and him crucified"?

For Prayer:

- Take some time and pray that God would lead you to prepare to be a Disciple Maker and that he would lead you to grow in your ability to understand, enjoy, and share the gospel.

REMEMBERING

Memorizing is one of the best ways of making truth stick. You can memorize something if you repeat it enough times. Try reading the verse 5 times a day until it sticks! Choose a part of it for your kids if needed.
