Community Group Questions

Everyday Disciple:

1. What opportunities have you had to love, serve, or bless those who don't know Christ this past few weeks?
2. How is God growing, challenging, and working on you? What areas of your life do you see him moving?

Sunday Sermon:

1. Read Colossians 1. Just spend some time talking through the flow of the passage. What is Paul saying? What is praying? What is in his heart for the people of Colossae?
2. Look again at verses 15-20. Jot down or say out loud every statement that Paul makes about Jesus in this passage. Which statement, title, or teaching do you find the most amazing?
3. In what area of your life are you tempted to look to or worship lesser things than God?

Application and Prayer:

1. Pray that God would ignite in our hearts a deeper love, sense of wonder, and joy in Jesus and all that he's accomplished for us.
2. Christians have a long history of singing and worship.
