Community Group Questions

Everyday Disciple:

1. What has been your experience or thoughts regarding the Corona pandemic?
2. Has it given you any opportunities to talk about spiritual things with your friends, family, or coworkers?

Sunday Sermon:

1. What are some things in your life that you have considered among your greatest treasures?
2. What are some of the things that keep us from recognizing Jesus as the all time greatest treasure?
3. What are the practical implications of being "encouraged in heart and united in love". How does it happen and what does it look like?

Application and Prayer:

1. Read Matthew 13:44 and consider the implications of seeing Jesus as a treasure that was that valuable? How would that affect the way we live?
2. When we value something it affects the way we think and live. What can you do this week to raise the value of Jesus as the greatest treasure in your life?
3. Pray that we would think carefully about how we value Christ as our source of wisdom and knowledge.
