SERMON TEXT: 1 Peter 1:1-5

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Have you had the opportunity to reach out to those in your life who are currently isolated? How did you do it (phone, video, text)? Who could benefit from your investment and care?
2. Pastor Deven said that chaos often brings pain, struggle and, at times, even a difficulty in praising God? What truths from the text that we looked at on Sunday give you reason to worship no matter what you're facing? What is eternally secure and yours in Christ?
3. Who in your life can you be praying for this week to receive this "new birth" that Peter talks about? Remember your Next Door List. Pray for these people - that God would give them a living hope, through Christ's resurrection.
