SERMON TEXT: Philippians 4:7, 8

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. How do you find your thoughts flowing in these times? Are you having a hard time focusing on what is true, noble, right, etc? Read Philippians 4:8 and use Paul's list to evaluate your thinking.
2. Jesus knows what it's like to experience fear. Read Hebrews 4:15. Why is this so comforting in times of pain, uncertainty, or difficulty? How has Jesus walked this path before you in his earthy life and suffering?
3. What would it look like for you to glorify God in your thinking during times of uncertainty? How would this ultimately be good for you and your mental/emotional/spiritual health?
