### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

1. How have you seen hypocrisy lived out in your own life and experiences? How do you feel when you see someone acting hypocritically?
2. As Followers of Jesus, we're called to live like Jesus. Sounds simple, but it's hard. Which of the virtues listed in this passage do you find the hardest to live out consistently? How did Jesus perfectly embody this for you?
3. How has the gospel changed you? How is it changing you day-by-day? How have you seen God make you different than you were before him, or, apart from him?
